The Arkansas State Police have told us that there are no restrictions on reprinting the driver's license manual. NSC is free to print the manual by downloading the manual from the internet. However they have cautioned that they are in the process of reprinting the manual with some changes. The ASP is in the process of changing printers due to contract restrictions with their current printer. They would prefer that the NSC publication contain the new revised version of the manual. The corrections will hopefully be completed in the next few months. If you like I would work with the ASP to get permission for the printer to release their typeset copy to you. Please advise me as to what you want us to do.

This has taken longer than I anticipated but we finally have the go ahead from Arkansas. I apologize for the delay. If we can ever be of any additional service to you or any of your colleagues please let us know.

Sorry for the length of time that it is taking to get you the Arkansas Driver's License manual reprint permission. WE have the support of the Colonel at the ASP. There is a little catch. There is existing an Attorney General's opinion that is shaky on whether or not state published information can be reprinted by a third party. The ASP along with the Governor's office is seeking a clarification of the AG's opinion and the end result is that the ASP is favorable to allowing the NSC to publish the manual. We are waiting on a new AG's opinion.

The idea is to obtain a less critical or even supportive opinion from the AG. Either way it is possible that we can have your permission in the near future.
